Important Solid Waste & Recycling Collection Information for Seven Valleys Borough for 2026

Dear Seven Valleys Borough Resident,

Please be advised that Penn Waste has been awarded the Solid Waste and Recycling contract for the term of 1/1/26-12/31/28. We look forward to continuing to service the residents of Seven Valleys Borough. Our goal is to provide you with superior customer service. **Mobile cart usage will be required under this contract.** Please review the contents of this flyer for useful information on your collection.

Please have your material placed at the curb by 6:00 AM as we will start promptly. We recommend placing your material at the curb the evening before your collection day. Your collection day will remain the same under this new contract. Your weekly collection will consist of the following options below. Under this contract the usage of carts will be required for collection.

Penn Waste is the exclusive hauler for Seven Valleys Borough under this contract. The service levels are as follows:

DON'T Toss That Tank!

Never place pressurized tanks in your curbside trash or recycling!

These containers, such as propane, oxygen, and nitrous oxide tanks, are dangerous and can cause fires, explosions, or harm to our team members.

Instead: Take Tanks to an Authorized Drop-off Site.

- ▶ Check with your local solid waste authority to see if they accept them.
- ▶ Contact the supplier for returns options.

Mobile Cart Delivery



As part of the new contract, Penn Waste will be distributing Trash carts to residents. You may call our customer service team by December 19, 2025 to make your selection. If a selection is not made by this date residents will automatically be placed on the Basic Service option.

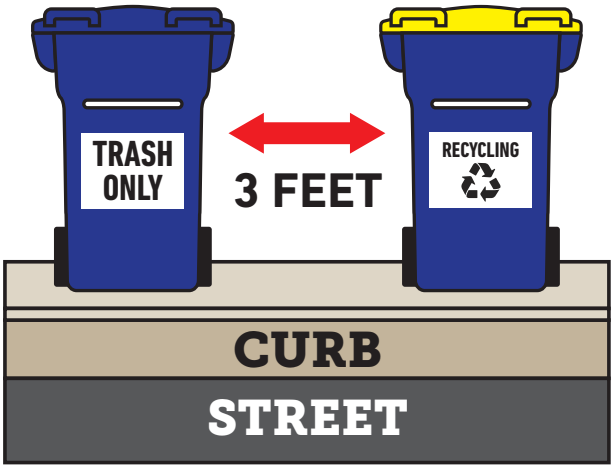
If you currently have a 96-gallon Penn Waste trash cart, you may continue to use it and the rental fee on your bill will be discontinued. All residents should already have a 64-gallon recycle cart. If you do not have a recycle cart, please call our customer service team at (717) 767-4456 option 3.

The mobile carts will be delivered to residents prior to the start of the new contract. You may begin using your cart as soon as you receive it. The utilization of the mobile cart is required for collection by all residents under this contract.

Proper Cart Placement

Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road.

- Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:
- ◆ Set mobile cart out the evening before pickup day.
 - ◆ Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
 - ◆ Do not place cart in the roadway.
 - ◆ Do not block walkways with carts.
 - ◆ Place carts at least THREE FEET APART from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.



Bulk Item Guidelines



Seven Valleys Borough residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week. Please have your bulk item available for collection at the curb the evening before your collection day.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS – Appliances (including those containing freon like refrigerators and air conditioners), furniture, mattresses, box springs, two (2) car tires off the rims, lawn mowers (oil and gas removed), plumbing fixtures such as sinks and toilets, three (3) 4ft rolls of carpet (tied).

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into the truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Observed holidays are noted in RED. Collection days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed one day. EXCEPTION: If holiday falls on a Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, there is no change in service prior to or after the holiday.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- Trash, recycle and (1) bulk item must be at the curb by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- Residents are limited per week to what will fit inside the mobile carts for trash and recycling.
- Bulk items that are too heavy to be lifted by two people will not be accepted.
- No construction debris will be collected curbside.
- Rechargeable batteries and pressurized tanks (propane cylinders, oxygen tanks, nitrous oxide canisters) should never be placed in your curbside trash or recycling. Please contact your local solid waste authority for disposal options.
