HELPFUL HINTS

Non-Hazardous Recycling:

- ✓ Have your recyclables separated from your garbage load
- ✓ Flatten your cardboard
- ✓ Rinse all bottles, milk cartons & jugs, etc.
- ✓ Microwaves and small appliances are not recyclable
- ✓ Printers, keyboards and computer mice are not recyclable
- ✓ Vinyl and rubber are not recyclable
- ✓ Plastic Bags are not recyclable
- ✓ Freezer Food Packaging is not recyclable

- ✓ Have all liquids in a container you can leave behind
- ✓ Do not mix different hazardous products
- ✓ Have all hazardous material in its original container
