

TRASH & RECYCLING

GARBAGE COLLECTION

Household garbage should be disposed of in the grey curbside container. It is picked up once a week by Waste Connections. Waste Connections utilizes fully automated curbside waste collection, so please follow the guidelines outlined below when curbing your roll-out.

- Place your containers curbside by 7:00am on your collection day. Please leave space between the carts of 3 feet.
- Leave 2 feet between the container and a stationary object such as a mailbox.
- Bag your trash. Trash that is not bagged can end up on the ground and in yards- Keep your neighborhood beautiful.
- Place your roll-out container within 4 feet of the road. Do not place the roll-out next to your mailbox.
- Make sure it is clear of trees and overhanging limbs.
- Make sure the wheels of your roll-out are away from the road (the lid of the trash can should be facing the street).
- Make sure your lid is open no more than 12 inches above the rim.
- Excess trash should not be placed on top of the can or around it. We will only dump trash that is within your can.
 - If you have additional bags of trash for pick-up, you may contact the Huntersville Engineering and Public Works Department to arrange for bulk pick-up at 704-875-7007. Please be advised there is a fee associated with this service.

NON-COMPLIANT TRASH

Household garbage that does not meet the above criteria will be deemed non-compliant. If the resident makes household garbage conform, it will be collected at the next regularly scheduled pick-up.

RECYCLING

Recycling is collected once every two weeks by Waste Connections on the same day as trash and yard waste collection. Recycling should be curbside in the designated blue container by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. The method of collection is single-stream, so all recyclable items can be placed into your 96 gallon cart.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

- Do not bag up recyclables.
- Please leave space between all curbside containers of 3 feet. Leave 2 feet between a container and stationary object such as a mailbox.
- Do not put household bulk trash into your recycling container. Just because it fits, does not mean it belongs there. You can have bulk trash picked up by arranging a bulk pick-up. This service is offered to our customers on a fee per item basis.
- Rinse food and residue from your recyclables.
- Make sure your container lid is completely shut when placing it curbside.
- Only place items designated for recycling into your curbside containers. Please do not place plastic bags or wraps in your container.
- Do not put electronics or batteries in your curbside containers.

RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Recycling is collected once every two weeks. A residence is either collected on "A week" or "B week." Learn when recycling is collected at your residence being serviced.
